Instructions

Required materials

- 1 DIY Panel, art. 03260 from POPPY FABRICS
- Sewing machine and sewing thread
- Fiberfill sheets
- Cotton filling
- Fusible interfacing
- Needle and thread
- Thin plastic sheets
- Velcro circles x6
- Elastic

Pattern pieces

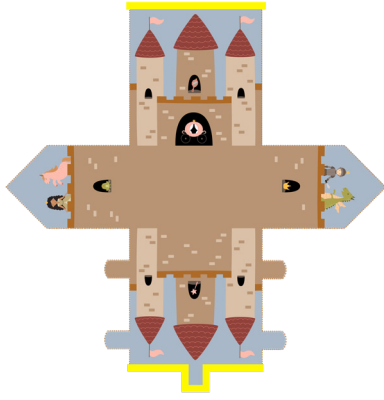
1. Castle dollhouse 1x
2. Window shutters 4x
3. Nightstand door 1x
4. Closet doors 2x
5. Castle door 1x
6. Princess 1x
7. Skirts 2x
8. Prince 1x
9. Cape 1x
10. Dragon 1x
11. Unicorn 1x
12. Bed 1x

Instructions

1. First, cut out all of the parts.

Castle dollhouse

2. Iron interfacing on the backside of 4 window shutters.
3. Pin the right sides of the window shutters together, sew around and leave an opening.
4. Turn the fabric and close the opening.
5. Repeat this step for all window shutters, for the closet doors, nightstand door and the castle door.
6. Place the outside of the castle on fiberfill and pin in place.
7. Attach the window shutters on the 4 biggest windows on the outside of the castle.
8. Attach the castle door on the door opening on the outside of the castle.
9. When attaching the window shutters and castle door, only attach them on one side, so the windows and doors can be opened and closed.
10. Attach the closet doors and nightstand door to the



- correct place on the inside of the castle .
11. When attaching these doors, only attach them on one side so the doors can be opened and closed.
 12. Pin the outside and the inside of the castle right sides together.
 13. Sew together but leave the top sides (marked with yellow) of the castle open, this is where the handle goes later on.
 14. Trim access fiberfill and fabric.
 15. Clip the corners and turn inside out.
 16. Press fusible interfacing on the blue handles.
 17. Fold and sew the edges of the handles.
 18. Measure from both sides equally and fold.
 19. Mark the depth of the handle and insert into the opening and close the bottom opening.
 20. Cut 2 plastic sheets in the correct size and insert them into the left and right wall of the castle for stabilisation.
 21. Sew along the bottom of the walls to secure the plastic sheets.
 22. Cut a rectangle plastic sheet to fit into the roof.
 23. Insert it and stitch to close.
 24. Cut and insert another rectangle to fit in the wall of the castle.
 25. Sew to close and secure.
 26. Repeat these steps until you reach the other roof.
 27. Cut and insert the last piece of plastic into the roof of the castle.
 28. Tuck the raw edges and insert the leftover handle.
 29. Pin in place and stitch to close.
 30. Hand stitch to connect the walls without the flaps together, so only one side of the castle opens up.
 31. Stick Velcro circles on the flaps, and on the castle so the castle can be closed.

Princess

32. Place the princess with the right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for the cotton filling.
33. Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.
34. Topstitch the bun of the princess.

Skirts

35. Fold and stitch the bottom part of the skirts.
36. Fold the top part of the skirts and but elastic in between, stitch the top part of the skirts.
37. Attach the sides of the skirts together, pin in place and stitch together.

Prince

38. Place the prince with the right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for the cotton filling.
39. Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.

Cape

40. Place the capes with the right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for turning.
41. Turn the fabric, and close the opening.
42. Stick Velcro circles to the cape so it can be worn by the prince.

Bed

43. Trace the base of the bed (light pink) onto a fiberfill sheet and cut out.
44. Trace the blanket of the bed (dark pink) onto a fiberfill sheet and cut out.
45. Place the base of the blankets and the fiberfill sheet right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for turning.
46. Turn the fabric and close the opening.
47. Optional: you can leave the blanket as is, or you can attach it to the base of the bed.
48. Place the base of the bed and the fiberfill sheet right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for turning.
49. Turn the fabric and close the opening.
50. Place the pillows right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for turning and cotton filling.
51. Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.
52. Repeat these last two steps for both pillows.
53. Optional: stick velcro circles to the pillows, and to the bed so the pillows stick to the bed.

Unicorn

54. Place the unicorn with the right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for the cotton filling.
55. Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.
56. Optional: Topstitch between the body and the legs of the unicorn.
57. Optional: Topstitch between the body and tail of the unicorn.
58. Optional: Topstitch between the body and the mane of the unicorn.

Dragon

59. Place the fabrics for the legs with the right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for the cotton filling.
60. Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the

opening.

- 61.** Place the fabrics for the arms with the right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for the cotton filling.
- 62.** Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.
- 63.** Iron interfacing on the inside of two of the wings.
- 64.** Place the fabrics for the wings with the right sides together, stitch together.
- 65.** Place the fabrics with the right sides together, stitch together leaving an opening for the cotton filling and wings.
- 66.** Attach the wings on the back of the dragon.
- 67.** Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.
- 68.** Attach the arms and legs to the body of the dragon.
