# Instructions

### **Required** materials

- 1 DIY panel, article 03250 from POPPY FABRICS
- Matching fabric for the backside 95 x 90 cm, we recommend Poplin, art. 06006.038
- Optional: Teddy fabric 12 x 12 cm for page 2 of the book, we recommend 07030.001
- Optional: Suede fabric 12 x 12 cm for page 4 of the book, we recommend 08010.009
- Cotton filling
- Interfacing
- Sewing machine and stitching thread
- Needle and thread
- Rope or ribbon
- Optional: Crisp paper
- 4 wooden rings

#### Pattern pieces

- **1.** Playmat acorn front 1x
- **2.** Babygym hangers 4x
- **3.** Activity book 1x

# Cut to size

- 1. Fabric for the backside 1x W90cm x H95cm
- 2. Fabric for page 2 1x W12cm x H12cm
- **3.** Fabric for page 4 1x W12cm x H12cm

# Instructions

**1.** First, cut out all of the parts.

# Acorn playmat

- 2. Place the two stems with the right sides together, stitch all the way around, leaving an opening for the cotton filling.
- **3.** Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.
- **4.** Place the front side of the acorn on the back side fabric with the right sides together, pin in place and cut the same shape as the acorn.
- 5. Stitch front and back together with the stem in between leaving an opening for the cotton filling.
- 6. Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.
- 7. Optional: topstitch along the thin lines.
- 8. Place the leaves with right sides together, stitch all the way around, leaving an opening for the cotton filling.
- 9. Turn the fabric, fill with cotton filling and close the

opening.

- **10.** Optional: topstitch along the thin lines.
- **11.** Sew the leaf to the stem of the acorn.

#### Babygym hangers

- **12.** Place the fabrics with the right sides together and stitch together leaving an opening for the cotton filling. Add a ribbon in between the fabrics for the hangers to attach to the babygym.
- **13.** Turn the fabrics, fill with cotton filling and close the opening.
- **14.** Optional: add a rattlebox inside the babygym hangers.

#### Activity book

**15.** Iron interfacing on the following parts: Pages 3, 4, 5, 6 and on the navy strip of P1 and P8.

#### Page 1

16. Requires no editing.

#### Page 2

**17.** Optional: add a teddy fabric to the belly of the bear, we recommend: art. 07030.001.

#### Page 3

- **18.** Add crisp paper on the inside of one of the wings.
- **19.** Place the right sides of the wings together, stitch together leaving an opening for turning.
- **20.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **21.** Attach the wings to the bee on page 3 of the activity book.

#### Page 4

**22.**Optional: add a soft fabric to the antlers of the moose, we recommend: art. 08010.009.

# Page 5

- **23.** Iron interfacing on the inside of one of the tree stumps.
- **24.** Place the right sides of the tree stumps together, stitch together leaving an opening for turning.
- **25.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **26.**Optional: topstitch the lines.
- **27.** Attach the tree stump in front of the squirrel on page 5 of the activity book.

#### Page 6

- **28.** Iron interfacing on the inside of one of the leaves.
- **29.** Place the right sides of the leaves together, stitch together leaving an opening for turning.
- **30.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **31.** Optional: topstitch the lines.
- **32.** Attach the leaf in front of the hedgehog on page 6 of the activity book.

#### Page 7

- **33.** Iron interfacing on the inside of one of the mushroom top and stem.
- **34.** Place the right sides of the top of the mushroom. together, stitch together leaving an opening for turning and the stem.
- **35.** Place the right sides of the stem together, stitch together leaving an opening for turning.
- **36.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **37.** Add the stem to the top part of the mushroom and close the opening.
- **38.** Attach the mushroom in front of the mouse on page 7 of the activity book.

# Page 8

- **39.** Requires no editing.
- **40.** Place P2 and P7 with the right side on the right side of P1 and P8. Sew all around, and leave an opening to turn.
- **41.** Turn the fabric and close the opening.
- **42.** Repeat this step for the other pages.
- **43.** Put the pages on top of each other in the correct order.
- **44.** Topstitch on both long sides of the navy strip.
